To advance the implementation of the reforms under Ease of Doing Business (EoDB), Business Reforms Action Plan (BRAP) and Business Reform Action Plan Plus (BRAP Plus), the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Government of India, has proposed a Government Order/Notification for the following:

- The Department should ensure that all applications are submitted online via SWS / 1. NSWS, with no requirement for submitting hard copies. Offline applications should not be accepted. Furthermore, all information related to these services should be published online. Additionally, the development and publication of a dashboard with key metrics (applications received/granted, time taken, fees incurred) should be undertaken, with regular updates (real-time or daily/weekly, etc.) for the services included in BRAP and BRAP+, as outlined in Annexure A. Format for dashboard is also attached at the end.
- 2. Establishment of an Online Grievance Mechanism by the Department, with defined working procedures and an escalation matrix, including service timelines and procedures for addressing and responding to businesses' grievances, as outlined in Annexure B. Additionally, time-bound resolution of queries and grievances should be defined.
- The Department should ensure that all processes outlined in Annexure C are being 3. followed.

In this context, it is proposed that the General Administration Department (GAD) direct the respective Departments to adhere to the above points.
